R - *Hail Mary...*

Let us pray: O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord.

R - have mercy on us and on the whole world. *(x 3 times)*

R - O Blood and Water which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You.

My God, I believe, I adore, I trust and I love You! I beg your pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust and do not love you. *(x 3 times)*
